# ORDINANCE NO. <u>2014-10-07</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ELECTED OFFICIALS SALARIES.

WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 5; Article XI, Section 8; and Article XXX, Section 1 of the Washington State Constitution allows the state legislature to delegate to the legislative authority of the County the right to prescribe salaries of its own members and the salaries of other County officials; and

WHEREAS, the legislature granted such authority to the County Commissioners in RCW 36.17.020; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, RESOLVED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD OF

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLARK COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 1984-06-73; as most recently amended by Sec. 1 of Ord. 2012-09-01 and Clark County Code 2.10A.035 are each amended to read:

#### 2.10A.035 Commissioner Salaries.

The annual salary to be paid members of the Board of County Commissioners for the period January 1,  $20((\frac{13}{13}))$  through December 31,  $20((\frac{16}{15}))$  shall be as follows:
