25	Commissioners concluded that placing the issue on the ballot for an advisory vote
26	would be in the best interests of the economic wellbeing, public health, safety and
27	welfare of the Citizens, now therefore:
28	BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
29 30	COMMISSIONERS OF CLARK COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:
31	COMMISSIONERO OF CEARIN COUNTY, CTATE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS.
32	The Board requests that the Auditor of Clark County conduct an election on November
33	4, 2014 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the County, for their approval or
34	rejection, Resolution 2014-07-27 which supports a proposed toll-free East County
35	Bridge and a community embraced projects policy; and

37	The Clerk of the Board is authorized and directed to certify, no later than August 5,
38	2014, to the Auditor a copy of said resolution and the proposition to be submitted at that

58	provided in RCW Chapter 29A.32 and the rules and guidelines of the County Auditor.		
59	The names of the committee members appointed shall be provided to the Auditor by		
60	August 5, 2014 and arguments for approval or disapproval of the ballot measure shall		
61	be provided to the Auditor by August 14, 2014. The explanatory statement shall be		
62	prepared by the Prosecuting Attorney and filed with the Auditor on or before August 15,		
63	2014.
