<b>BACKGROUND</b> : The current wash rack system at our 78 <sup>th</sup> Street Operations Center is in its 13 <sup>th</sup> year of a 10-year replacement cycle. We have been able to get three additional years past it's scheduled replacement date, but replacement parts are now difficult to find and purchase. The unit is failing and needs to be replaced. We are asking to purchase a new water recycling system for our wash rack at 78 <sup>th</sup> Street Operations Center to replace the existing unit.
