#### FISCAL IMPACT ATTACHMENT

#### Part I: Narrative Explanation

I.A - Explanation of what the request does that has fiscal impact and the assumptions for developing revenue and costing information.

These two projects, being bundled together for cost savings, will construct approximately 0.60 mile of concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, as well as ADA ramp upgrades to provide a safer pedestrian path along busy county roadways.

The Hazel Dell Avenue Sidewalk Project will construct approximately 2,100 linear feet of sidewalk on the east side of the roadway, from north of NE Alki Road to NE 63rd Street. Work will include utility relocations, new stormwater facilities and installation of retaining walls.

The NW 68<sup>th</sup> Street Sidewalk Project will construct about 1,200 linear feet of sidewalk on the south side of the street between NW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Work will include utility relocations, new stormwater facilities and an asphalt overlay of the roadway.

Total cost for the projects is \$884,059; \$427,000 from a federal grant and \$457,059 County Road Fund.






**Vicinity Map**
