Part I: Narrative Explanation

I.A - Explanation of what the request does that has fiscal impact and the assumptions for developing revenue and costing information.

This project will improve railroad crossings on NE St Johns Road (S. of NE 78th St.) and on NW Fruit Valley Road (S. of NW 78th St.). NE St Johns Road will remove existing track, crossing structure and road crossing surface material and replace with 136-lb rail, concrete tubs, new subgrade/ballast, conduit, underdrain pipe and asphalt. In addition, new sidewalk and truncated domes will be installed.

NW Fruit Valley Road will remove existing track, crossing structure and road crossing surface material and replace with 136-lb rail, concrete panels, crossties, new subgrade/ ballast, conduit, underdrain pipe and asphalt.

Total Cost of the project is \$475,000 from County Road Fund/fully reimbursed by State grants.

Project revenue consists of \$435,000 from WSDOT Freight Rail Assistance Program (FRAP), and \$40,000 from Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC), equaling the total estimated project cost. This is currently in the 2014-2019 TIP, and included in the Road Fund budget for 2014.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until 1:50 P.M. on Tuesday, August 26, 2014, by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners through the General Services Purchasing Department, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660, for the NE St. Johns Road & NW Fruit Valley Road Railroad Grade Crossing Reconstruction projects, Tracking No. 028700; and other work; then publicly opened and read aloud at the Commissioners' Hearing Room, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Vancouver, Washington 98660, at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, August 26, 2014, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

Description of work

NE St Johns Road:

Remove existing track, crossing structure and road crossing surface material and replace with 136-lb rail, concrete tubs, new subgrade/ ballast, conduit, underdrain pipe and asphalt. In addition, new sidewalk and truncated domes will be installed.

NW Fruit Valley Road:

Remove existing track, crossing structure and road crossing surface material and replace with 136-lb rail, concrete panels, crossties, new subgrade/ ballast, conduit, underdrain pipe and asphalt.

In the event a bidder cannot access the County's Website, a FAX copy of the form can be obtained from and returned to the County's Construction Management Office (FAX 360-397-6087).

Answers to bid questions will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log", also located on the County's Internet page, which will be updated twice daily, at noon and 6:00 PM. The questions and answers posted on the Bid Inquiry Log will not identify who asked the question, nor will that information be provided otherwise. It is considered exempt from Freedom of Information requirements. The last Bid Inquiry log update prior to bid opening will be 6:00 PM the day before the bid opening, and will display all guestions and answers to the questions that have accumulated by the posting time. Questions asked after this time will not be addressed. Questions too late to be answered as of that posting will remain unanswered and will not be included in the log.

All bids shall be delivered to the attention of the Clark County Purchasing, P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, Washington 98666-5000 or 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650. Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope, marked "Sealed Bid", which clearly states the name of the bidder, the project number, the project title, the date of the bid opening, and appropriate wording to indicate definitely the nature of the contents. Do not send bids by FAX or email. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

A bid proposal deposit, made in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid proposal, shall accompany all bid proposals. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Clark County Road Fund.

The right is reserved by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the call for bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the Contracting Agency is served.




