This project will move access to our Clark County Operations site approximately 75-feet to the east so that it lines up with NE 47 th Avenue, creating a new 4-legged signalized intersection. This project will widen the south leg of the NE 47 th Avenue intersection to include a northbound left turn lane. Clark County Operations' old access on NE 78 th Street will be removed and replaced with curb, sidewalk, and landscaping. The railroad signal will be upgraded. New railroad gate arms and cantilevers will be installed across all legs of the intersection.							
For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will temporarily close portions of NE 47 th Avenue and NE 78 th Street. The closures are planned for three weekends, from Thursday evening (9:00PM) to early Monday morning (6:00AM). Periodic single lane closures will be also be necessary for the duration of the project, which is expected to be completed by January 2016. Public notice and detour information will be provided.							
<u>COMMUNITY OUTREACH</u> : This project is included in the adopted 2014-2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP development undergoes a wide array of public input processes, including a public hearing, SEPA, and an internet web site. We have sent Heads-Up mailers and held an open house for the adjacent property owners. We will be working with business and property owners for the lane closures and ful road closures. We will advise all affected parties of the upcoming road closures, and will work with them accordingly.

Part I: Narrative Explanation

I.A - Explanation of what the request does that has fiscal impact and the assumptions for developing revenue and costing information.

The existing "T" intersection of NE 47th Avenue and NE 78th Street is not signalized and has no turn lanes on the south leg on NE 47th Avenue. Chelatchie Prairie Railroad Tracks bisect the intersection.

This project will move the access to Clark County Operations approximately 75-feet to the east so that it lines up with NE 47th Avenue, creating a new 4-legged signalized intersection. The new, north leg of NE 47th Avenue leading to the County's Operations facility will have a northbound thru lane and a southbound combined left/thru/right lane. This project will widen the south leg of the NE 47th Avenue intersection to include a new left turn lane. Clark County Operations' old access on NE 78th Street will be removed and replaced with curb, sidewalk, and landscaping. The railroad signal will be upgraded. New railroad gate arms and cantilevers will be installed across all legs of the intersection.

NE 47th Avenue/NE 78th Street Intersection- Total construction cost for this project includes \$980,000 Federal Grant Funds, \$20,000 State Funds, and \$1,092,000 County Road Funds for a total cost of \$2,092,000. This project is included in the 2014-2019 Adopted Transportation Improvement Program and 2014 Annual Construction Program (Item# 2). This project is currently in the 2014 and 2015-2016 budgets.
