In January, 2014, the County took over the planning and administrative functions and formed a new Parks Division. Public Works developed a new Parks Administration budget as part of this new division. This was in addition to the Greater Clark Parks District Maintenance budget, the Volunteer budget, the General Fund Parks Maintenance budget, and the Campus Maintenance budget.
