

Charter Implementation Process Agreement
December 23, 2014

The citizens of Clark County approved a new County Charter form of county government on November 2014.

The transition from the Constitutional form to the Charter form of County Government will begin on the effective date of January 1, 2015 when the current Board of County Commissioners will become the Board of County Councilors, and their executive authority will be transferred to the acting County Manager.

The Council, with input from the County Manager, will develop an orderly process to identify and implement the amendments necessary to change all current rules, processes, practices, ordinances, and resolutions to complete the transition by January 1, 2016.

The process will be conducted in such a manner as to provide an incremental, well organized and thoughtful transition with the goal of implementing achievable changes by June 30, 2015. All changes will be agreed upon by the Councilors and County Manager before each is implemented and codified.

The County Manager will submit a draft document with recommended changes to the Councilors by January 31, 2015 for their consideration. They will then, in continued collaboration with the County Manager, craft the final documents necessary to step by step transition to the Charter government.

Diligent effort will be given to be cooperative and inclusive to ensure the stability and healthy continuity of operations to most effectively serve the people of Clark County while maximizing responsiveness and accountability to the citizens.
