



This limited amendment would improve consistency between the county's shoreline program and the state standards




Proposed change

Reason for change

Critical Areas Ordinances	 Better defines the relationship between CAO and SMP
 Revise exemptions from a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit 	 Adds language about demolished residences and normal maintenance
 Revise references to storm water 	Complies with state mandate by 01/08/2016
Revise specific use regulations	 Adds demolished or damaged language for existing residential structures
 Revise definitions for normal maintenance and normal repair 	Improves clarity of definition

GMA and **SMA**

- Shoreline management is 14th goal of GMA
- SMP regulates critical areas in shoreline jurisdiction
- Shoreline regulations must protect at least as well as critical areas regulations
