The nine-member Clean Water Commission is an advisory group that makes recommendations to the Board of County Councilors about services, policies and financing to meet federal and state requirements for water quality, including stormwater management.

Applicants can live anywhere in Clark County; residents of the unincorporated area are encouraged to apply. Analytical skills are desirable, along with experience and interest in environmental issues.
