ORDINANCE NO. 2015-01-07

An ordinance amending the inspection fees for erosion control facilities.

1	WHEREAS, the Board of County Councilors adopted fees for inspecting erosion
2	control facilities to comply with National pollution control requirements; and
3	WHEREAS, since the adoption of these fees, county staff, professionals from the
4	development community and the public have analyzed those fees and the consensus of
5	these groups is that a limited reduction of fees is appropriate; and
6	WHEREAS, this matter has been considered by the Development Engineering
7	Advisory Board who recommend its adoption; and
8	WHEREAS the Board held a duly advertised public hearing on January 6 th 2015
9	and after considering testimony found and concluded that adoption of this ordinance
10	would further the public welfare; Now, Therefore,
11	BE IT ORDERED, AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COUNCILORS OF
12	CLARK COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

³ The disturbed area fee calculation adds the fee component from each applicable area range. The fee formula calculates the area in acres using two (2) significant figures after the decimal point. For example, the fee for a project with two hundred (200) acres of disturbed area is(((nineteen thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$19,750) (\$19,750 = 450 + 2,000 + 2,800 + 9,500 + 5,000)) \$17,344 (17,344 = 350 + 94 + 1,000 + 1,400 + 9,500 + 5,000).
