

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-06-21

**A Resolution transferring equipment from Clark County to Clark Regional
Emergency Services Agency.**

1 WHEREAS, Clark County previously executed an Interlocal Agreement in 2001 to fund
2 the purchase of equipment and software to provide communications capability to various law
3 enforcement agencies; and

4 WHEREAS, payment for the acquisition of these services and equipment was undertaken
5 by Clark County; and

6 WHEREAS, debt service was paid to Clark County from Clark Regional Emergency
7 Service Agency (CRESA); and

8 WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement provided that upon payment, equipment contained
9 on the attached list (Exhibit "A") would be transferred to CRESA; and

10 WHEREAS, Clark County has verified, through the Auditor's Office, that funding is in
11 place to complete payments for all equipment contained on the attached "Exhibit A"; and

12 WHEREAS, CRESA has requested transfer of this equipment so that it may be utilized in
13 better and more efficient ways; now, therefore,

14 BE IT ORDER AND RESOLVED by the Board of County Councilors, County of Clark,
15 State of Washington, as follows:

16 1. All equipment contained on the attached "Exhibit A" is hereby transferred from
17 Clark County to CRESA, pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement executed in January 2001 and
18 recorded under Auditor's No.3304810 and County staff are directed to cooperate with CRESA to
19 facilitate and implement this Resolution.


