Curtis Children's Justice Center, where identification and prosecution of 125 perpetrators of abuse crimes last year made our neighborhoods safer and brought justice for the child victims involved; and, last year the Children's Justice Center multidisciplinary team helped hundreds of children receive healing, advocacy and family support services to promote recovery from significant trauma caused by criminal abuse; and

WHEREAS, this month the Board of County Councilors encourages all citizens to report suspicions of child abuse, knowing that a report to authorities offers the chance of intervention and prevention to save children from severe injury or death; and

WHEREAS, now, because the county's future depends on our care and nurturing of children who are the hope for a bright tomorrow, we, the Board of County Councilors, do hereby proclaim April 2015 as
