BACKGROUND

Public Works Road Maintenance Division has a 1979 force feed loader they use to maintain road shoulders. This machine is in need of some very expensive repairs in excess of \$30,000 and parts are very hard to find. The cost of these repairs will only get us by for the next season and making these repairs will not increase the value of this piece of equipment. Currently this unit is not on ER&R. Road Operations is requesting Fleet Service to purchase one used force feed loader and add it to ER&R. By adding this loader to ER&R, it will ensure them of a future replacement.

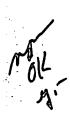
