BACKGROUND

To be in compliance with RCW 36.77.070, Clark County must publish a notice listing projects that used county forces in the previous calendar year and the cost of those projects. The county must also publish a notice of intent to use county forces on upcoming projects in the current calendar year and the estimated cost of those projects. The use of county forces is limited to levels established by formula in RCW 36.77.065. Clark County is well below the authorized limit. This approval authorizes publication of the required notices for 2014 and 2015.

None. Individual projects and ongoing programs listed in the notices are included in the Annual Construction Plan or Transportation Improvement Plan.

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
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

Transportation Program

- Traffic Signal Optimization at various locations on Highway 99, Hazel Dell Ave, NW 78th St, NE 76th St, NW 99th St, NE 50th Ave, NE 72nd Ave, Covington Rd, NE 137th Ave, NE Ward Rd, NE 162nd Ave.
- Signal inspection and testing for capital projects including NE 119th St @ Salmon Creek Ave, and NE 47th Ave @ NE 78th St.
- Incidental support of County Road Projects including NE 119th St @ NE 50th Ave, NE 10th Avenue (NE 141st-NE 149th St), NE 94th Ave (Padden Pkwy to NE 99th St), Highway 99 Interim Sidewalk (NE 99th St to Parkview Dr).
- Railroad crossing upgrade at NE 119th St @ NE 99th St.

Sidewalk/ ADA Program

- Sidewalk construction and ADA ramp construction or replacement at various locations including NE 43rd Ave @ McCann Rd, NE 44th St (City Limits to NE 42nd Ave), NE 49th St (City Limits to NE 40th Ave), NE 110th St (Hazel Dell Ave to NE 5th Ave), NE 111th St (Hazel Dell Ave to NE 5th Ave), and NE 5th Ave (NE 110th St to NE 112th St), Highway 99 (99th St to NE Parkview).

Pavement Preservation Program

Pursuant to Revised Code of Washington Section 36.77.070, notice is hereby given that the Clark County Board of Councilors has determined the following construction projects should be constructed by county forces during 2015. Specifically, this work involves:

Transportation Program

- Traffic Signal Optimization at various locations on Padden Parkway, NE 76th St, Covington Rd, NE 137th Ave.(Orchards TSO)
- Signal installation, inspection and/or testing for capital projects including: NE 119th St @ Salmon Creek Ave, and NE 47th Ave @ NE 78th St.
- Incidental support of County Road Projects including NE 119th St (NE 72nd Ave – NE 87th Ave), NE 47th Ave @ NE 78th St, NE 94th Ave (Padden Pkwy to NE 99th St)

Sidewalk/ ADA Program

- Sidewalk construction at various locations including NE Highway 99 (NE 63rd St to NE 78th St), NE 107th Ave (NE Covington Rd to NE 76th St), NE 131st St (NE Fourth Plain Rd to NE 76th St), NE 58th St (NE 59th Ave to NE Andresen Rd), 1200 block of NE 40th Ave.
- ADA Ramp construction and replacement at various locations including NW 99th St (NW 21st to NW 11th), NE 33rd Ave (NE 104th Ct – NE 106th St, NE 42nd Ave, NE 29th Ave (NE Salmon Creek Ave to NE 170th St), NE 88th St (NE 55th Ave to NE 62nd Ave), NE 38th and NE 39th St (NE 55th Ave to NE 59th Ave), NE 63rd St (NE 100th Ave to NE 105th Ave), NE 82nd St (NE 138th Ct to NE 142nd Ave), NE 6th St (NE 172nd Ave to NE 175th Ave)

Pavement Preservation Program


- Preservation Program: preparatory work, crack filling, signing, striping and placement of shoulder rock incidental to 2014 and 2015 overlays at various locations including NE Berry Rd, NE 277th Ave/Cavitt Rd/39th St, NE 237th Ave, NE 134th St/Laurin Rd, NE 131st St, NW 209th St, NW Hayes Rd, NE 134th St/Tenney Rd, NE 152nd Ave/Rock Creek Rd, NE 154th St/112th Ave, NE 156th St, NE 29th Ave, NE 222nd Ave/Finn Hill Rd., NE 159th St.

The Clark County Engineer estimates the construction costs for these projects will be \$ 277,000.
