#### BACKGROUND

To be in compliance with RCW 36.77.070, Clark County must publish a notice listing projects that used county forces in the previous calendar year and the cost of those projects. The use of county forces is limited to levels established by formula in RCW 36.77.065. Clark County is well below the authorized limit. This approval authorizes publication of the required notices for 2014 and 2015.
