BACKGROUND

Transmitted for acceptance by the Board is the plat of Birrel Estates Subdivision

Zoning: R-18 Single Family Residential utilizing the townhouse standards set forth in CCC 40.260.230-1 Density and Lot Size: The R-18 zone allows a minimum and maximum density of 12 and 18 units per acre respectively, with a minimum lot area of 1,800 sq. ft. The net developable area of 0.90 acres with 14 lots provides a density of 15.5 units per acre which meets density requirements. Lot Dimensions for R-18 zone is minimum lot width of 25 feet and minimum lot depth of 50 feet. Actual Lot Size: Minimum lot area 1,868 sq. ft. and maximum lot area 3,072 sq. ft. All proposed lots meet the lot dimension standards. The application vested on March 14, 2006, Pre-application conference was held on October 27, 2005, Final order of conditional approval was June 12, 2006.


The applicant is requesting to subdivide 0.9 acres into a 14 lot single-family residential subdivision located in the R-18 zone, using the County's townhouse provisions.


