BACKGROUND

Public Works is the owner and operator of Whatley Pit in a partnership with the Cities of Vancouver, Battle Ground, Camas, and Washougal, and Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT). The facility is used to store street sweepings and catch basin debris from all of these organizations. Historically, material from each agency was stored in bins and costs were allocated accordingly. WSDOT has offered to provide \$70,000 to purchase and install a vehicle scale, which will allow for a more accurate accounting method. Public Works will research, acquire and install the scale. Total costs are expected to be between \$70,000 and \$100,000 depending on options available. Public Works will fund the project and bill WSDOT for up to \$70,000 once the scale is installed.
