facilities. The stations consist of a roof mounted GPS antenna, and a GPS receiver and communication electronics inside each site. The latter requires approximately two (2) square feet of wall space. The installations will be part of a larger network of continuously operating reference stations in southwest Washington and northwest Oregon. The network allows users, when connected via internet, instantaneous survey grade GPS locations using a "rover" GPS unit. Trimble Navigation will provide one (1) network user license per installation to the County at no cost. The value of this license is \$1,650 each per year or \$4,950 for the three installations. There will be minimal cost to the county for electricity to power the units. The planned locations sites are the downtown Facilities building, the Washougal Public Works Shed and a yet-to-be-determined location.




