Owners of Lennar Northwest, Inc. have filed a petition for the vacation of NE 187th Avenue from the vicinity of NE 29th Street northerly 800 feet to its terminus. The county acquired this road in 1974 under Auditor's Files number G659165. The proposed vacation area is zoned (R1-6) Single Family Residence and is approximately 23,999 S.F or 0.55 acres.


