- There are 131 diverse employers

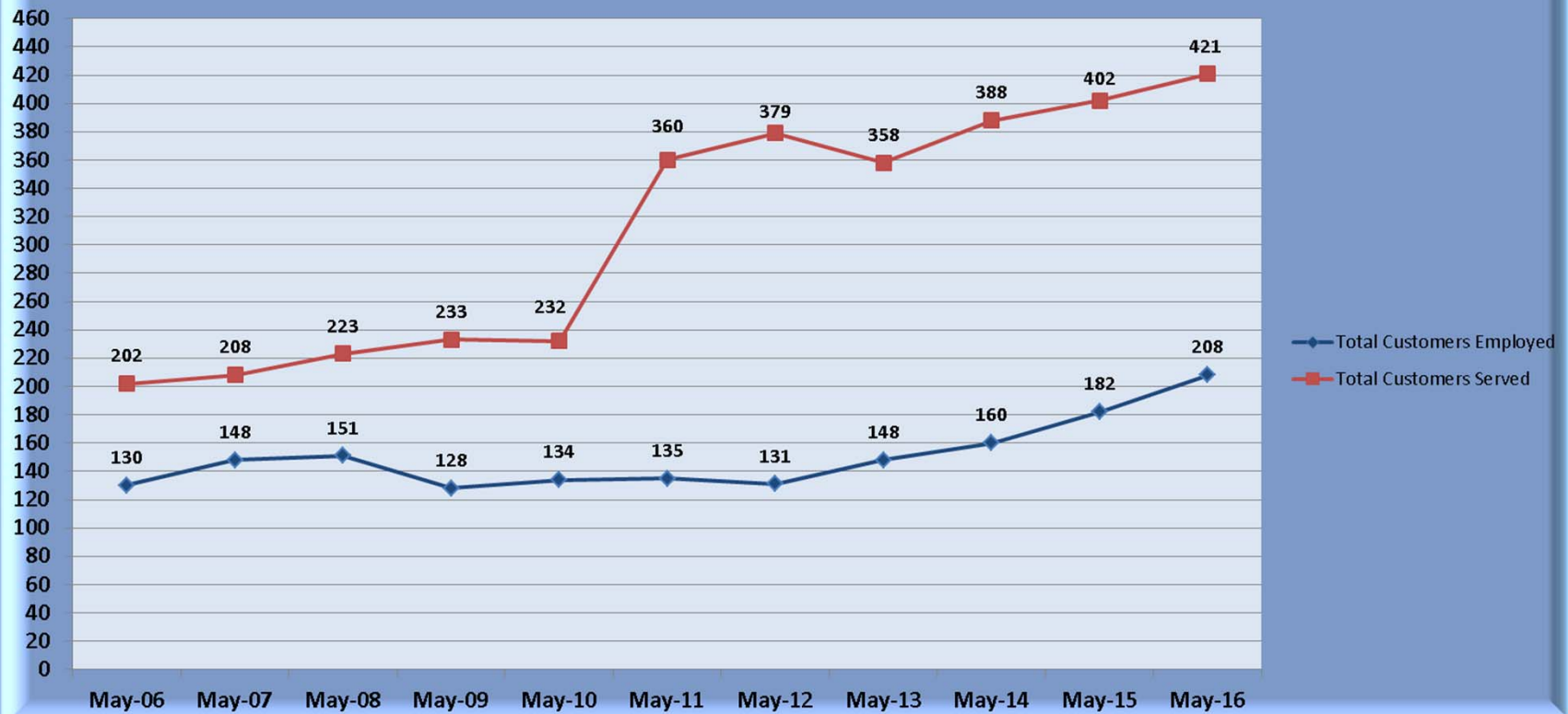
