- TIMING CONSIDERATIONS: Now that the 2016 Comprehensive Plan has been adopted, the next step is implementation and preparation for the 2024 update.
- 5. <u>DESIRED RESULTS</u>: The School Districts and ESD112 participated in the Quality Schools Task Force from 2005-2011. Their charge included the development of the Schools Element in the Comprehensive Plan. The districts would like to partner with the county on the implementation of the 2016 Comp Plan and revisit school issues.
- 6. <u>IMPACTS (COMMUNITY/FINANCIAL/STAFF/OTHER)</u>: Current land use plans and capital facilities funding mechanisms for schools present unique challenges under GMA. The challenge of providing quality education given growth and development is exacerbated by the recent McCleary decision and the significant number of at risk students.
- 7. <u>POLICY IMPLICATIONS</u>: None known.
- 8. <u>ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED</u>: Re-establish coordinated land use planning activities between the county and the districts; establishing a new advisory committee charge/timeframe, consider joint regional lobby efforts and coordination of educational programs to meet the future global economy.
