15	maintenance was submitted to the voters and rejected in the November 2012 General Election when voters defeated C-Tran Proposition One; and

17	Because the following question was put to the voters as Advisory Vote # 2 in the November				
18	2013 county-wide General Election:

20	"Should the Clark County Board of Commissioners approve proposed Resolution 2013-07-19				
21	which opposes every Bus Rapid Transit project in Clark County unless it is first supported by a				
22	majority of the voters in a county-wide advisory vote of the people?"; and

24	Because the majority of citizens in that election voted Yes and the Board desires to faithfully				
25 26	represent the will of the people and do as they directed; and				
26 27	Because this matter was considered at a duly advertised public hearing, where the Board of				
28	County Councilors concluded that adoption of this policy would be in the best interests of the				
29	public health, safety and welfare of the Citizens, now therefore:

31	BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COUNCILORS OF CLARK COUNTY,				
32	STATE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

34	The Board hereby adopts the findings and conclusions contained in the recital clauses above as				
35 36	findings supporting this resolution.				
36 37	The Board hereby adopts a clear policy to oppose every Bus Rapid Transit project in Clark				
38	County unless it is first supported by a majority of the voters in a county-wide advisory vote of
