

RESOLUTION NO. 2016- 01-07

A RESOLUTION ensuring that county policies are adopted in fulfillment of the spirit of the Clark County Home Rule Charter.

1 WHEREAS, in the General Election of November 4, 2014, the electorate of Clark County
2 approved a Home Rule Charter which called for the seating of a five-person council in 2016; and,

3 WHEREAS, Marc Boldt was elected as Council Chair and Julie Olson as Councilor for
4 Council District Two to fulfill the Home Rule Charter's requirements; and,

5 WHEREAS, the sitting County Council on December 22, 2015 approved eight (8) policy
6 resolutions by holding 7 public hearings and 1 public meeting on a single day; and,

7 WHEREAS, the resolutions considered and adopted give the appearance of being hastily
8 conceived and not of an urgent or emergent nature that would have required immediate review;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, the Council wishes to maximize its ability to independently make policy as
11 a five-person Council; now, therefore

12 BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED by the Board of County Councilors of Clark
13 County, State of Washington, as follows:

14 The following listed resolution adopted by the Clark County Council on December 22,
15 2015, is hereby repealed and rescinded:


20 This action does not affect the ability of the Council to consider this policy anew as

22 discretion of the Council.

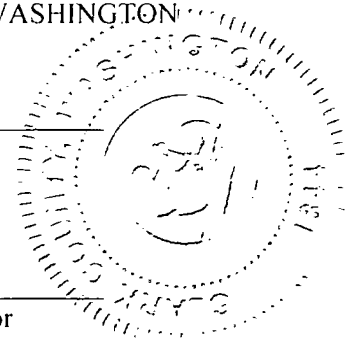



RESOLUTION NO. 2015-12-26

1 A RESOLUTION updating Clark County's policy embracing Free Market principles on zoning.

2
3 WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Councilors desires to lessen or eliminate the pressure that
4 pushes for ever shrinking lot sizes, ever higher residential density requirements, insufficient
5 parking, and constraints on mixed use zoning; and
6

7 WHEREAS, the Board, wishes to support Free Market Principles that allow more freedom for lower
8 residential densities and more flexibility property use options; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the Board, within the limits of the law, seeks to adopt compatible principles,
11 philosophies, and policies to guide priorities, advocacy positions, practices, and future plans; and
12

13 WHEREAS, future Board actions may repeal or amend this resolution as necessary to reflect new
14 principles, philosophies, and policies so as to ensure consistency with adopted policies; and
15

16 WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Councilors at a duly advertised public hearing, finds that
17 adoption will further the public health, safety and welfare; now therefore,
18

19 BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COUNCILORS OF CLARK COUNTY,
20 STATE OF WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

22 The Board hereby adopts the findings and conclusions contained in the recital clauses above as
23 findings supporting this resolution. The Board, within the limits of the law, adopts these principles,
24 philosophies, and policies to guide priorities, advocacy positions, practices, and future plans.
