REQUESTED ACTION: Establish CRP# 350822: NE 94th Avenue Planting and approve the attached Notice to Contractors to advertise the contract for bids.

BACKGROUND

The NE 94th Avenue (NE Padden Parkway to NE 99th Street) project to upgrade the roadway went out for bid in summer 2015 (BOCC approved SR-126-15 on June 16th, 2015). As a part of the same CRP, a second contract will be awarded to complete the planting separately.

The NE 94th Avenue Planting project will install plants, shrubs and trees in rain gardens along the NE 94th Avenue roadway improvement project (NE Padden Parkway to NE 99th Street). Rain gardens are being installed as part of the stormwater treatment plan. The planting is being contracted separately from the roadway construction due to the specialty nature of the work.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County may temporarily close portions of one travel lane to through traffic during construction.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The NE 94th Avenue project to improve the roadway was approved by the Board on June 16, 2015 (SR-126-15). The project is also included in the 2016-2021 Transportation Improvement Program, 2016 Annual Construction Program (#3) and adopted 2015-2016 budget.





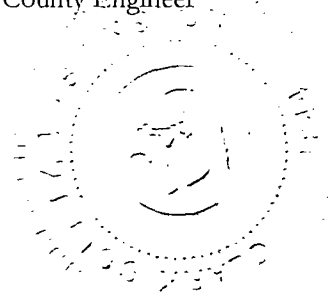

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT **NE 94th Avenue Planting**

lying: NE Padden Parkway to NE 99th Street

State Road Log No. 22753 from Milepoint 0.29 to Milepoint 1.09 will be improved as follows:

The NE 94th Avenue Planting project will install plants, shrubs and trees in rain gardens and along the NE 94th Avenue roadway improvement project (NE Padden Parkway to NE 99th Street). Rain gardens will be installed as part of the stormwater treatment plan. The planting is being bid separately from the roadway construction approved in 2015 due to the specialty nature of the work. (SR-126-15, June 16, 2015).

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County may temporarily close portions of one travel lane to through traffic during construction.

The construction documents are complete and we are ready to advertise the contract for bids. The advertisement is contained in the attached Notice to Contractors.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that an appropriation from the officially adopted road fund budget, and based on the County Engineer's estimate, is hereby made in the amounts and for the purposes shown:

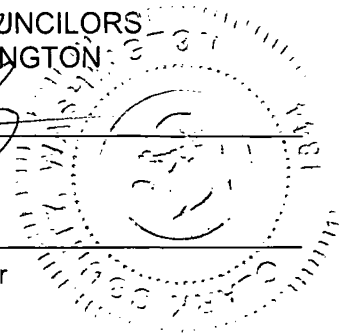

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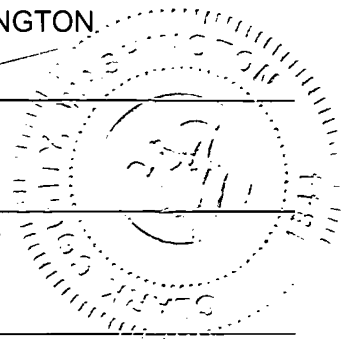

Description of work: Landscape, planting, maintaining of roadside planter strips, bio-retention cells and irrigation.

Answers to bid questions will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log", also located on the County's Internet page, which will be updated twice daily, at noon and 6:00 PM. The questions and answers posted on the Bid Inquiry Log will not identify who asked the question, nor will that information be provided otherwise. It is considered exempt from Freedom of Information requirements. The last Bid Inquiry log update prior to bid opening will be 6:00 PM the day before the bid opening, and will display all questions and answers to the questions that have accumulated by the posting time. Questions asked after this time will not be addressed. Questions too late to be answered as of that posting will remain unanswered and will not be included in the log.

All bids shall be delivered to the attention of the Clark County Purchasing, P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, Washington 98666-5000 or 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650. Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope, marked "Sealed Bid", which clearly states the name of the bidder, the project number, the project title, the date of the bid opening, and appropriate wording to indicate definitely the nature of the contents. Do not send bids by FAX or email. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

A bid proposal deposit, made in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid proposal, shall accompany all bid proposals. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Clark County Road Fund.

The right is reserved by the Clark County Board of County Councilors to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the call for bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the Contracting Agency is served.

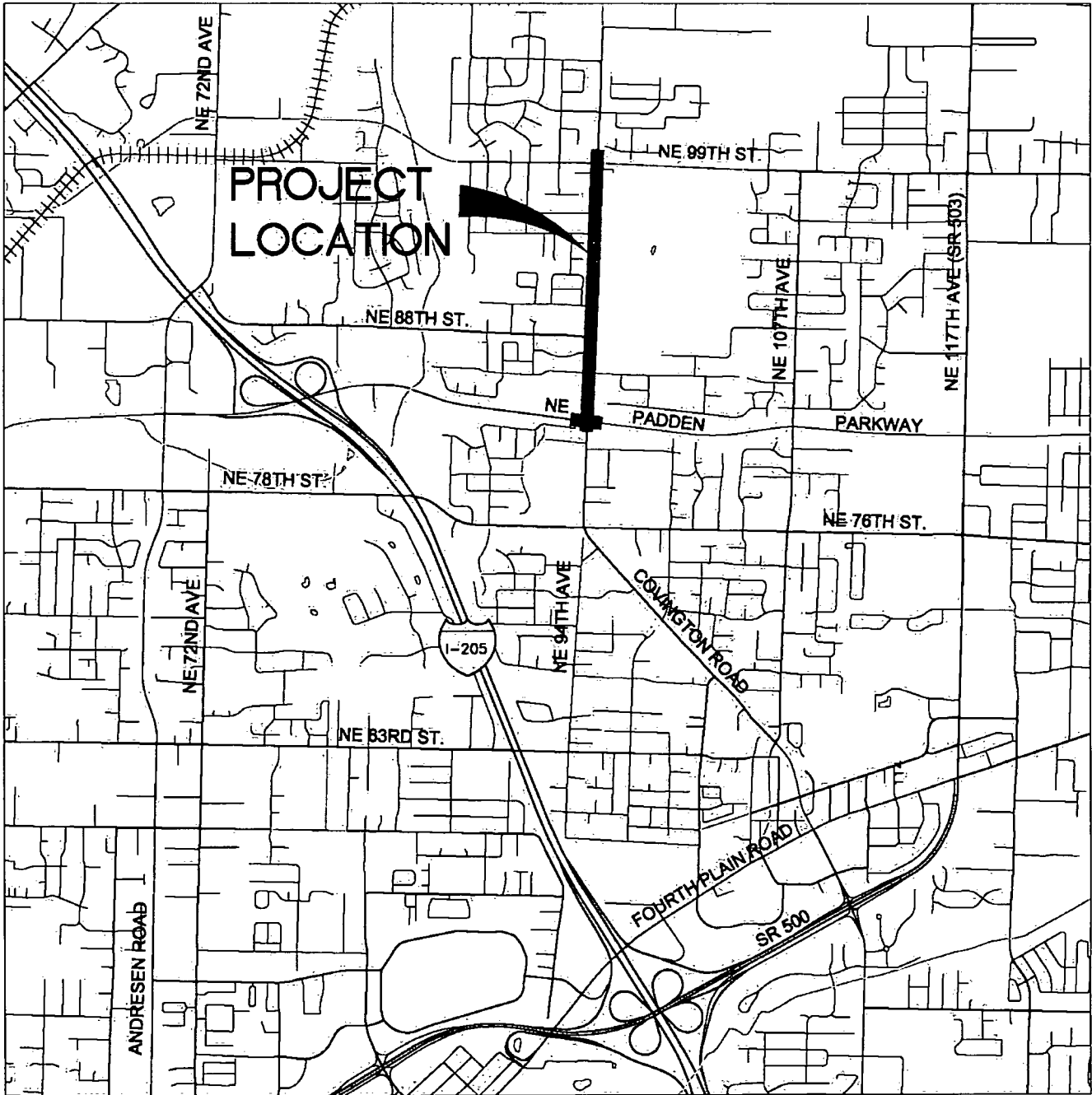
