

FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

In the matter of the Lennar Northwest, Inc., et al, for the partial Vacation of a County Road known as a portion of NE 187th Avenue located in Section 19, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, WM, Clark County, Washington.

The **BOARD** having on the 10rd day of November, 2015, ordered the vacation of said road upon payment by the principal petitioner of all costs and expenses incurred in the proceedings, and said costs and expenses amounting to the sum of Four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-four Dollars and 23/100 (\$4,434.23), having been paid to the Treasurer of this County on the 8th day of December, 2015, and all conditions being met, including the recording of an easement filed under AF# 5259839.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE BOARD, all members concurring, that the County Road petitioned to be vacated by Lennar Northwest, Inc, et al.

Legal Description

A strip of land thirty (30) feet in width being the West thirty (30) feet of the following described property and as described under AF# G65165:

That certain portion of the East half of the East half of Section 19, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, WM, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section and running thence North 0° 42' 39" East, along the West line of said Subdivision of Section 19, a distance of 670 feet; Thence, North 89° 59' 20" East, 140.00 feet; Thence, South 0° 42' 39" West, 800 feet; Thence, South 89° 59' 20" West, 140.00 feet; Thence, North 0° 42' 39" East, 130 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Reserving a non-exclusive easement to Clark County over all said right of way for all public and private utilities for ingress, egress, constructing, reconstructing, installing, enlarging, extending, operating, maintaining, repairing infrastructure, and providing new services.

Said easements shall remain in effect until such time the petitioners record replacement easements with all impacted utilities.
