BACKGROUND

The NE Salmon Creek Ave. – 119th St. Traffic Signal Conduit Project will install fiber optic cable to enhance the operation of county traffic signals, providing additional operational redundancy. Location being improved is:

NE 117th Street from Highway 99 to NE Salmon Creek Avenue.

The 2016 Conduit and Detection Project will upgrade signals to include radar detection and cameras to be consistent with current county signal standards. Intersection locations include:

- Highway 99 at NE 20th Avenue
- Highway 99 at NE 129th Street
- NW 78th Street at NW 9th Avenue

The SE Eaton Boulevard Railroad Crossing Project will replace a damaged railroad signal and crossing equipment near Grace Avenue in Battle Ground. This crossing is part of the county-owned Chelatchie Prairie Railroad.

These projects are being bid and constructed together to maximize cost savings and efficiency. The County Manager will approve the bid award after advertisement and opening bids.




