BACKGROUND

This is a request to advertise the following two projects as a single contract:

The Hayes Road N&S Safety Improvements Project will install and upgrade guardrail and end terminals, improve slopes and shoulders and relocate utility poles from the roadside clear zone at three locations on NW Hayes Road.

The Washougal River Road and Lockwood Creek Road Safety Improvements project will install and upgrade guardrail end terminals, improve slopes and shoulders, construct walls and relocate utility poles at five locations on SE Washougal River Road and four locations on NE Lockwood Creek Road.

A 2015 federal safety program grant will pay 100% of construction costs. These projects are being bid and constructed together to maximize cost savings and efficiency. The County Manager has authority to approve the bid award after advertisement and opening bids.





Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on October 11, 2016** for: **CRP No. 352822, Hayes Rd N and S Safety Improvements and CRP No. 351622, Washougal River Rd & Lockwood Creek Rd Safety Improvements.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Installation of guardrail in various locations along Hayes Road, Lockwood Creek Road and Washougal River Road.

Primary bid items: Guardrail and Soldier Pile Wall

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

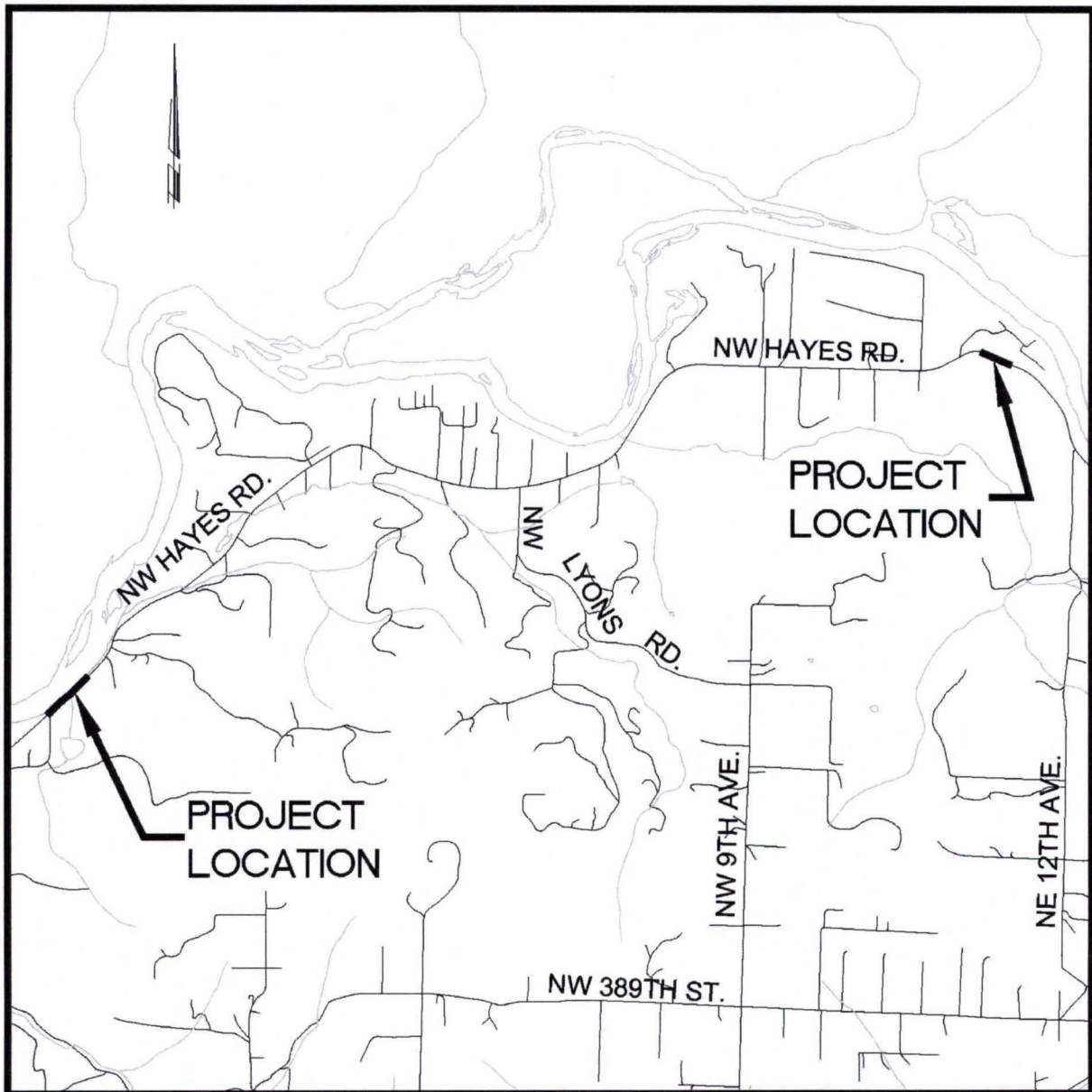

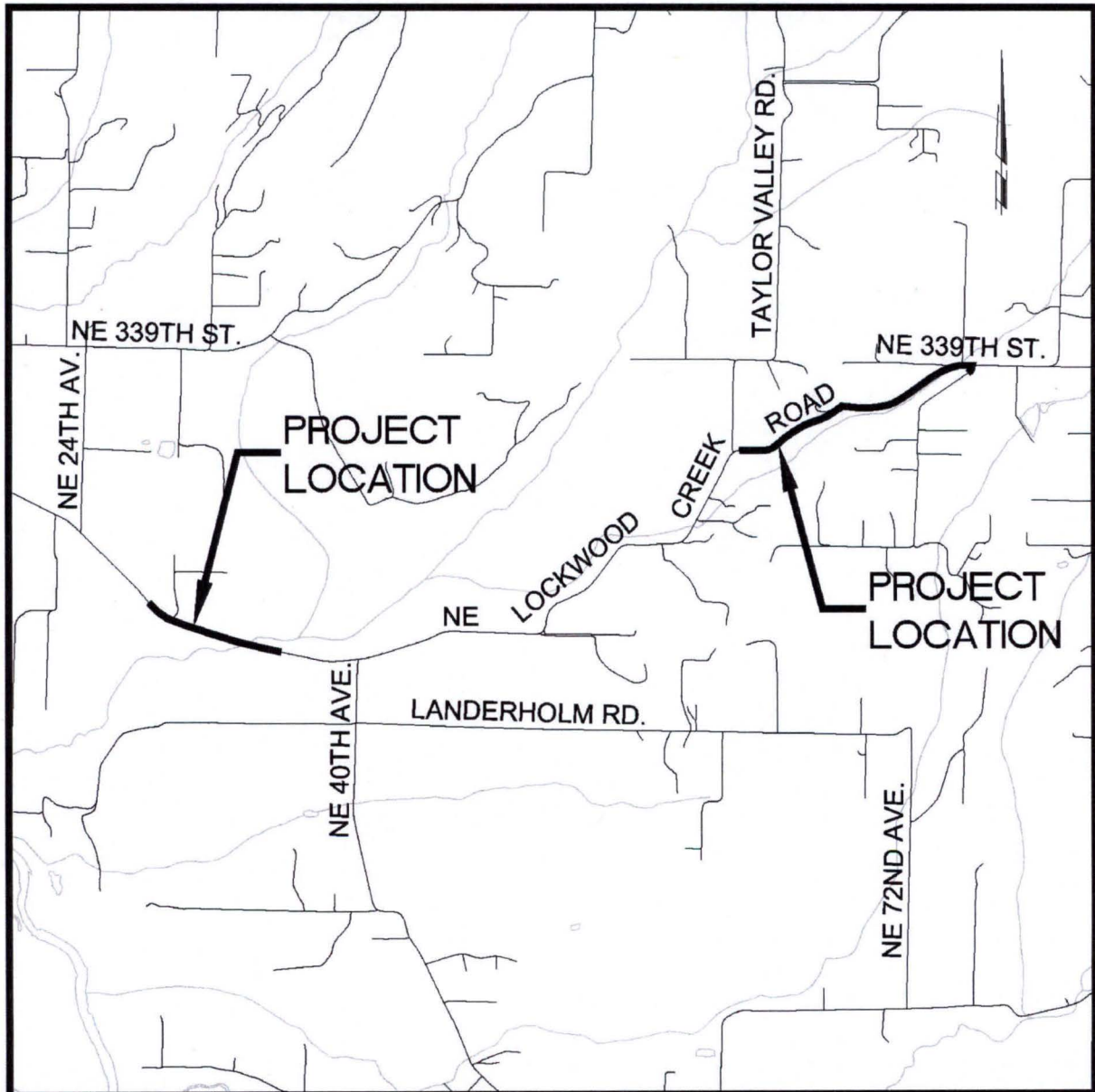
Vicinity Map
