BACKGROUND

The 2015 Guardrail and Bridge Rail project will replace and upgrade guardrail at one site on NE Berry Road and three sites on NW Hayes Road. Bridge rail will be replaced on Brush Prairie Bridge #201 on NE 156th Street near NE 102nd Avenue as well as Dudley Bridge #225 on NE 199th Street near NE 237th Avenue.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will implement alternating single-lane closures, 24-hours a day at Dudley Bridge #225 and Brush Prairie Bridge #201 during bridge-rail replacements. Overlegal vehicles will be restricted during these times. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020.

The County Manager has authority to approve the bid award after advertisement and opening of bids.



Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Removal and installation of new guardrail and bridge rail throughout Clark County.

Primary bid items: Guardrail and Bridge Rail

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.
