BACKGROUND

The applicant is proposing to divide approximately 27 acres into 139 single-family residential lots, located in the R1-5 zone district. The subdivision will be developed in two phases, Phase 1 consist of 60 Lots. Because a significant portion of the site is encumbered with wetlands, the Density Transfer provisions of 40.220.010.C.5 are being utilized. The minimum and maximum average lot areas are 5,000 and 7,000 square feet, respectively. Lots in this development are proposed to meet the R1-5 dimensional standards, ranging in size from 4,000 square feet to 8,200 square feet. Minimum lot depth for "regular" R1-5 zoned lots is 65 feet all lots are at least 90 feet deep. Minimum lot width is 45 feet all lots in the development exceed 45 feet. The application vested on April 6, 2015; Pre-application conference was held May 15, 2014; Final Order of conditional approval was June 22, 2015.
