The NE 99th Street at SR-503 project will improve the failing intersection to current standard by adding turn lanes, bike lanes, curb, and pedestrian facilities. The traffic signal will be upgraded to improve mobility and safety, for a total cost of \$2,160,000.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will close NE 99th Street for approximately eight weeks with intermittent lane closures between March 2017 and November 2017. Additionally, WSDOT will close some dedicated turn lanes of SR-503 during the construction period. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) awarded a grant to support the construction costs. The County Manager is scheduled to approve the bid award on January 3 after advertisement and bid opening.



Description of work: The proposed intersection will be adding a south to westbound right turn pocket on SR-503 and will be widening NE 99th Street to accommodate a single through lane, left turn lanes and right turn pockets in each direction.
