**REQUESTED ACTION:** Approve the attached Notice to Contractors to advertise for bid CRP# 390822: NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street at SR-503 Intersection, and authorize a full road closure of NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street.

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## **PUBLIC WORKS GOALS:**

- Provide safe and efficient transportation systems in Clark County

## **BACKGROUND**

The NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street at SR-503 project will improve the failing intersection to current standard by adding turn lanes, bike lanes, curb, and pedestrian facilities. The traffic signal will be upgraded to improve mobility and safety, for a total cost of \$2,160,000.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will close NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street for approximately eight weeks with intermittent lane closures between March 2017 and November 2017. Additionally, WSDOT will close some dedicated turn lanes of SR-503 during the construction period. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) awarded a grant to support the construction costs. The County Manager is scheduled to approve the bid award on January 3 after advertisement and bid opening.

## **COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

None. This project supports the Council's guidelines in investing in the county road system by providing safer and efficient transportation systems.







IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT **NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street at SR-503 Intersection**

lying on NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street at SR-503, State Road Log No. 23940 from Milepoint 2.62 to Milepoint 2.86 will be improved as follows:

The NE 99th Street at SR-503 project will improve the failing intersection to current standard by adding turn lanes, bike lanes, curb, and pedestrian facilities. The traffic signal will be upgraded to improve mobility and safety.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will close NE 99th Street for approximately eight weeks with intermittent lane closures between March 2017 and November 2017. Additionally, WSDOT will close some dedicated turn lanes of SR-503 during the construction period. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

The construction documents are complete and we are ready to advertise the contract for bids. The advertisement is contained in the attached Notice to Contractors.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on December 20, 2016** for: **CRP No. 390822, NE 99<sup>th</sup> Street at SR-503 Intersection.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: The proposed intersection will be adding a south to westbound right turn pocket on SR-503 and will be widening NE 99th Street to accommodate a single through lane, left turn lanes and right turn pockets in each direction. Stormwater collection and treatment systems. Traffic signal installation.

Primary bid items: (Ex) Roadway Excavation (Incl. Haul); Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA Cl. \_\_ PG 64-22 ;Storm Sewer Pipe; Manholes; Conc. Traffic Curb And Gutter; Conc. Sidewalk; Traffic Signal; Traffic Control

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

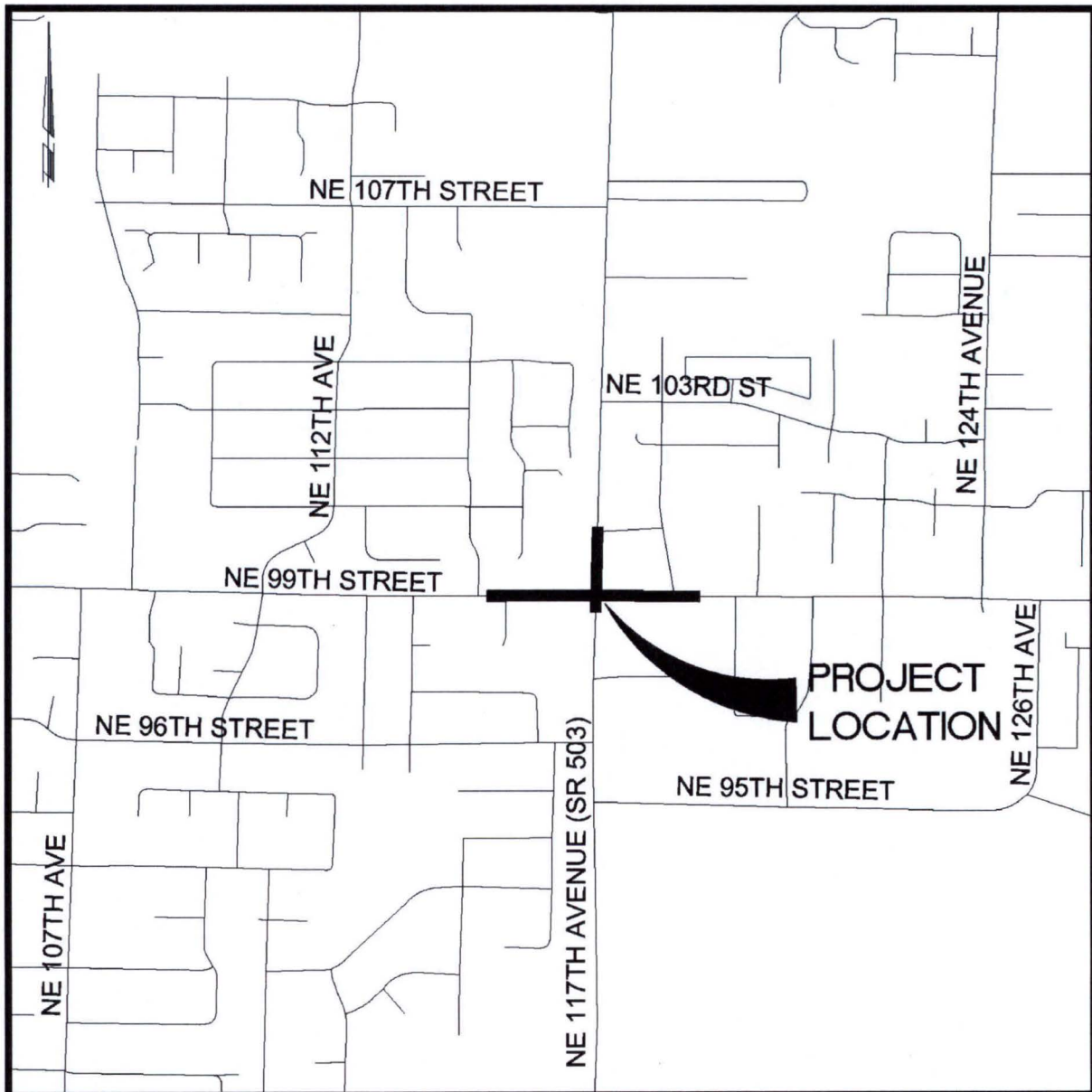
