BACKGROUND

The Clark County GIS Department has traditionally acquired aerial photography every 2 years. The 2016 aerial project is a budgeted project which will not have any additional fiscal impact.

The 2016 aerial project will provide ortho data. The ortho-photography data involves the traditional "straight down" view of the landscape (e.g., building rooftops).

Clark County is participating in a consortium with other local governments in the Portland area. Geoterra is the recommended vendor and their proposed cost is \$95,385 to perform this work.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The GIS Department has approached other cities, schools, utility agencies, and county departments to express the benefits and costs of the aerial photography project. This effort yielded several project partners that have agreed to make a financial contribution to assist with the acquisition of the aerial data, services and software.

BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

The primary source of funding for this project will be GIS fund. There is sufficient funding in the budget and fund balance for this project. This project does <u>not</u> require additional funding over what is already budgeted and available.

ORDER AND AGREEMENT

IT 16-37 Metro Contract #934218

Metro's Data Resource Center (DRC) at the request of the Aerial Photography Consortium (Consortium) has entered Into a Contract with GeoTerra® for the purpose of terrestrial aerial photos. In accordance with DRC's responsibilities to the Consortium and legally binding conditions with GeoTerra® the following intent to purchase, terms and conditions are provided.


THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the DRC and Clark County (hereinafter referred to as "User").

1. PRODUCT ORDERED

1.1 User chooses to participate in the 2016 aerial photo consortium and plans to purchase digital images at a maximum sum not to exceed NINTY-FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$95,385.00).

1.2 Area of Interest

1.3 Deliverables

2016 Clark County 6 inch Orthorectified Images (698 plss sections) \$95,385

- 666 sections that are fully finished.
- 55 sections that are fully finished within the Clark county boundary and partially finished outside the Clark County boundary

2. LIMITED WARRANTY

2.1 Limited Warranty.

- (a) User shall have the sole authority and responsibility to determine whether the Product, at the time of delivery, is free of defect, by performing quality control procedures as the product is received.
- (b) DRC disclaims any warranties, express or implied, respecting these terms and conditions or the Product.
- 2.2 Remedy.
- (a) User's sole and exclusive remedy for breach of this limited warranty will be to return the Product within 60 days of receipt.
- (b) DRC shall, at its discretion, retain the returned Product and refund the fee for the Product, or replace the Product, or repair the Product and return it to the User.

3. LIABILITY

DRC shall not be liable for any activity involving the Product with respect to the following:

- (a) The fitness of the Product for a particular purpose.
- (b) The installation of the Product, its use or the results obtained.

4. MISCELLANEOUS

4.1 Invalidity.

If any term or provision of this agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall to any extent be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement shall not be affected thereby, and each term and provision of this agreement shall be valid and enforced as written to the fullest extent permitted by law.

4.2 Entire Agreement.

This agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the matters covered hereby, and no other agreement, statement or promise made by any party hereto, which is not contained herein, shall be binding or valid.

5. AGREEMENT.

User shall supply and ship external hard drives for data delivery as needed. Metro will invoice User as Metro receives invoices from Contractor for work done in User's area of interest.
