IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT copies of this resolution be filed with the County.

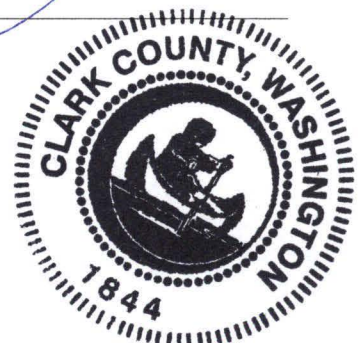
