REQUESTED ACTION: Establish CRP# 362122, 2017 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Overlays project and approve the attached Notice to Contractors to advertise the construction contract for bids; approve road closure.

BACKGROUND

The 2017 HMA Overlays project will improve 9.38 miles of county roadways with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlays as part of the county's annual Road Preservation Program. The road segments that will be overlaid are detailed on the attached vicinity map.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, this project will temporarily close portions of one travel lane to through traffic during construction from June 1, 2017 to October 31, 2017. Additionally, this project will close the intersection of Highway 99 and NE 78th Street for approximately three nighttime work shifts. Also, this project will close the segment of NE Padden Parkway from NE 78th Street to NE Andresen Road for two weekends. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the adopted 2017-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2017 Annual Construction Program (#17) as well as the adopted 2017-2018 biennium budget.

This project is listed in the adopted 2017-2022 Transportation Improvement Program and adopted 2017 Annual Construction Program. The TIP community outreach included two work sessions and a hearing with the Board of County Councilors, presentations to Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, the Clark County Finance Committee, as well as neighborhood outreach and internet web sites. Also, the SEPA review was included in the Capital Facilities Plan approval process.





Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on March 7, 2017** for: **CRP No. 362122, 2017 HMA Overlays.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Improvement of various county roadways by planing, pavement repair, over-excavation, roadway surface preparation, cleaning, sweeping, pre-leveling, applying tack coat, hot mix asphalt overlays, approach transitions and other related work.

Primary bid items: Flaggers, HMA Class ½ In. PG 64-22, HMA for Pavement Repair, Planing Bituminous Pavement.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

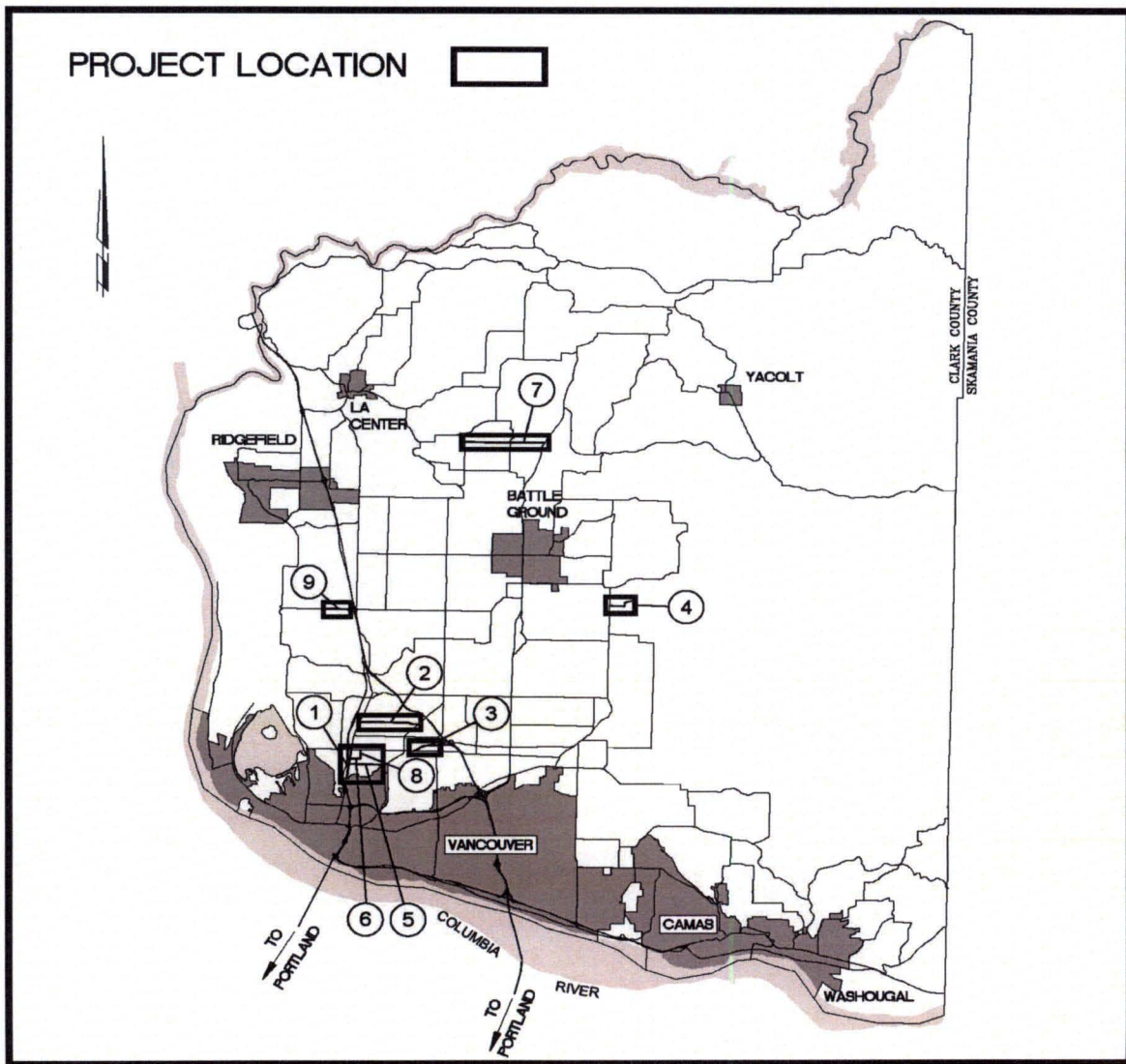
