BACKGROUND

This project will construct a bridge and road improvements on NE 10th Avenue between NE 154th Street and NE 164th Street. These improvements include road widening to add a center turn lane, bicycle lanes and sidewalks. A bridge over Whipple Creek will be constructed to connect the gap on NE 10th Avenue just north of 154th Street. Stormwater treatment, environmental mitigation planting, and utility relocations are also included in the project.

Clark County will close NE 10th Avenue north of NE 154th Street and south of NE 164th Street to through traffic for the duration of the project for the safety of workers and the traveling public. Specific closure dates and notices will be provided to the public in accordance with RCW 47.48.020.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project supports the Council's policy of investing in maintenance of the county road system, providing safe, efficient and multimodal transportation systems for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2017-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), 2017 Annual Construction Program (Item #1) and 2016/2017 Biennium Budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The TIP community outreach included two work sessions and a hearing with the Board of County Councilors, presentations to Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, the Clark County Finance Committee, as well as neighborhood outreach and internet web sites. In addition, a SEPA review was included in the Capital Facilities Plan approval process.





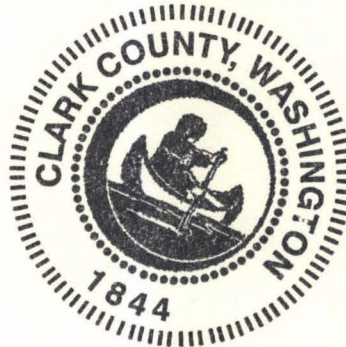

lying along NE 10th Avenue State Road Log No. 41471 from Milepoint 0.33 to Milepoint 0.69 and State Road Log No. 41150 from Milepoint 0.00 to Milepoint 0.02 will be improved as follows:

This project will construct a bridge and road improvements on NE 10th Avenue between NE 154th Street and NE 164th Street. A bridge over Whipple Creek will be constructed to connect the gap on NE 10th Avenue just north of 154th Street. 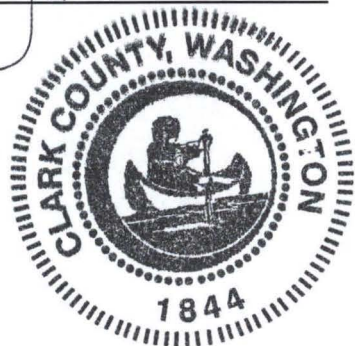

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M.** on **March 21, 2017** for: **CRP No. 370922, NE 10th Avenue** (from NE 154th Street to NE 164th Street).

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Construction of a new bridge over Whipple Creek; construction of roadway, curb, gutter and sidewalks; and construction of stormwater, water and sanitary sewer systems.

Primary bid items: Structural Low Alloy Steel; Bridge Deck – NE 10th Avenue; Stone Column Ground Improvements; Structural Earth Wall; Constructing 6-Ft. Diam. 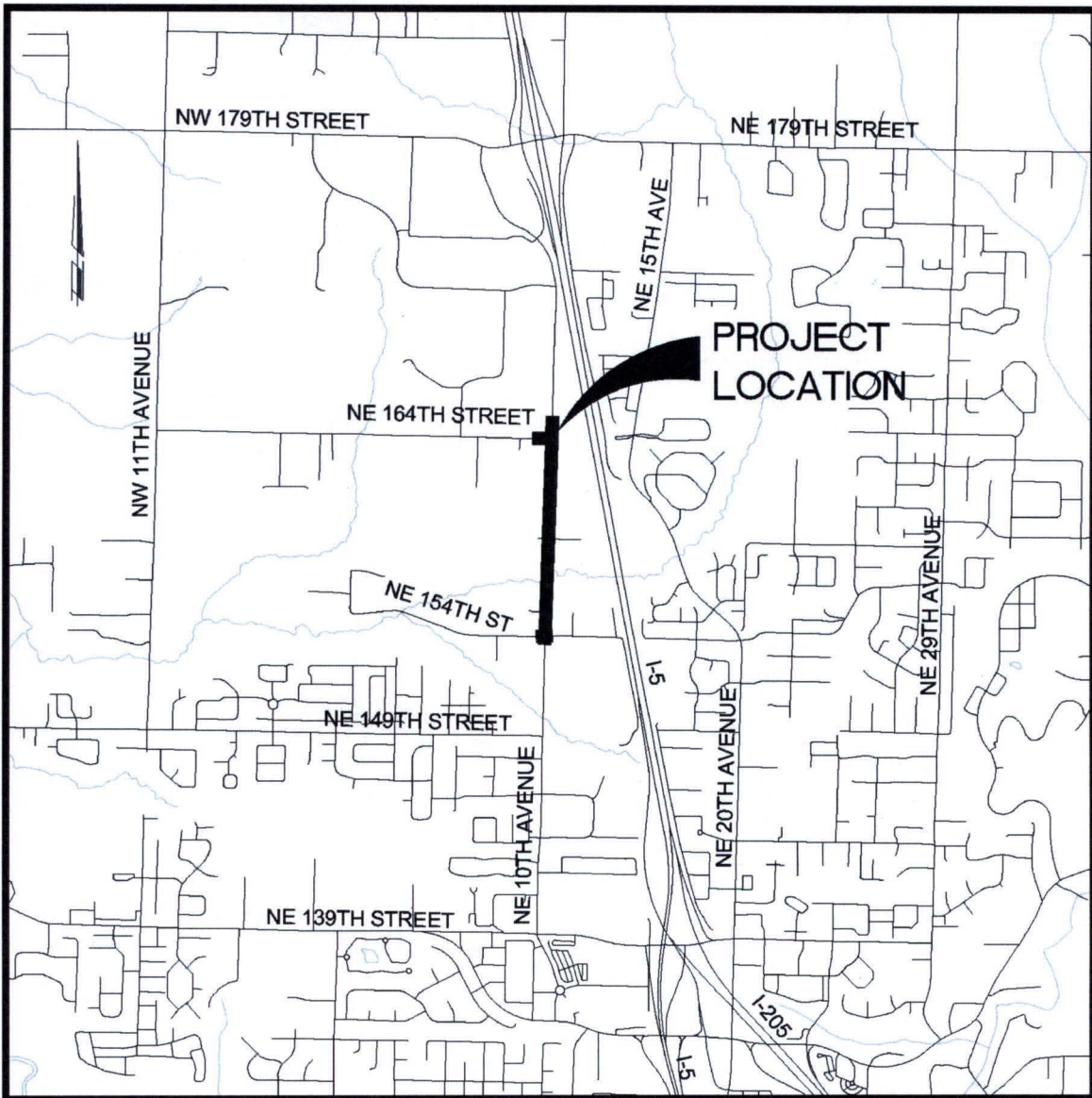
