BACKGROUND

The Salmon Creek Street Slide Repair Project will repair and stabilize the embankment in the slide area on NE Salmon Creek between NE 50th Avenue to NE 53rd Avenue. Improvements include building a gabion basket retaining wall and extending rip-rap into the stream. In addition, a concrete barrier and guardrail transitions will be installed along the roadway to meet the current roadway safety standards.

To ensure the safety of workers and traveling public, Clark County will close NE Salmon Creek Street for approximately eight weeks. Specific closure dates and detour information will be provided to the public according to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

Public Works anticipates receiving Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grant funding for the Salmon Creek Street Slide Repair Project, which will help reimburse expenditures and fund construction. The bid is scheduled to be advertised March 15, 2017, upon FEMA's approval.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This agreement supports the council's policy of investing in the county road system by providing safe and efficient transportation systems for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2017-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), 2017 Annual Construction Program (#20) and the 2017/2018 Biennium Budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is listed in the Adopted 2017-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Adopted 2017 Annual Construction Program. The TIP community outreach included two work sessions and a hearing with the Board of County Councilors, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, Development and Engineering Advisory Board and Clark County Finance

Committee, as well as neighborhood outreach and information on Internet websites. In addition, a SEPA review was included in the Capital Facilities Plan approval process. Property owners near the project were contacted during the design phase and a Project Heads Up will be sent to area property owners as construction nears.

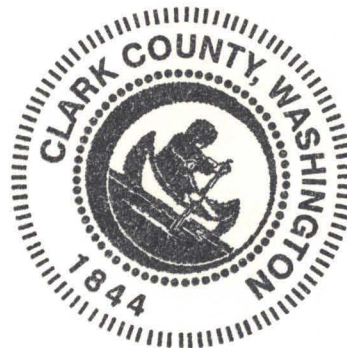

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on April 4, 2017** for: **CRP No. 362512, Salmon Creek Street Slide Repair**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Board of County Councilors, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This project will repair approximately 50-feet of eroded stream bank, caused during storm events, utilizing rock rip-rap and gabion baskets. The improvements will extend 60-feet on either side of the failure to facilitate integration of the wall into undisturbed soils. Precast concrete barrier and guardrail will be installed as part of this project.

Primary bid items: (Ex) Roadway Excavation (Incl. Haul); Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA Cl. PG 64-22; Gabion Cribbing Wall; Traffic Control; Channel Excavation Incl. Haul; Water Diversion; Guardrail; Precast Concrete Barrier

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

The County reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, reject any or all bids, or cancel the bid if the best interests of Clark County are not served.

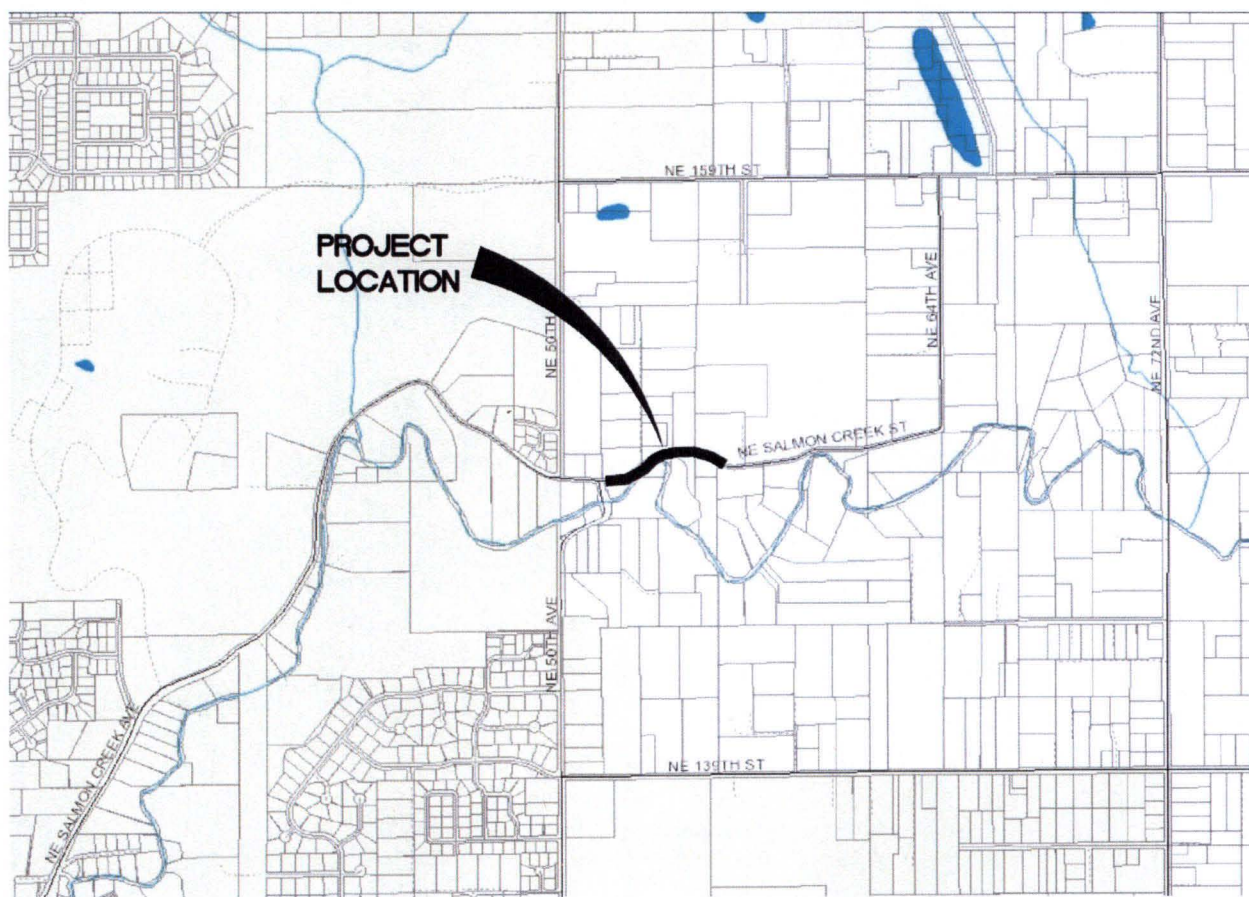
