### **BACKGROUND**

This project will improve NE 119th Street from NE 50th Avenue to NE 72nd Avenue to a two-lane minor arterial with center turn lane/median, bike lanes and sidewalks. Utility work and stormwater mitigation will be included in this project. The segment of NE 119th Street completes the western gap of the 119th Street corridor.

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, Clark County will restrict traffic on NE 119th Street between NE 50th Avenue and NE 72nd Avenue to local traffic only. Through traffic will be detoured during construction which will be approximately May 2017 to October 2018. Variable message sign notification will be provided to the public for five days prior to and five days after the traffic restriction. The speed limit in the construction area also will be reduced to 25 miles per hour. A Heads Up mailer will be sent out approximately one month before construction begins, to notify the surrounding public of the project. Specific traffic restriction dates and detour information will be provided to the public in accordance to RCW 47.48.020 Notice of Closure or Restriction.

The construction documents are complete, and we are ready to advertise the contract for bids. The advertisement is contained in the attached Notice to Contractors.

### **COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

None. This agreement supports the council's policy of investing in the county road system by providing safe and efficient transportation systems for all county residents.
