BACKGROUND

RCW 35.61.130 requires metropolitan parks districts to conduct records checks, including a fingerprinting check, for all employees, volunteers and independent contractors who have unsupervised access to vulnerable populations or are responsible for collecting or disbursing cash or processing credit/debit card transactions. Until 2017, the Greater Clark Parks District used the Clark County Sheriff's Office for fingerprint checks. The Sheriff's Office is no longer able to provide this service. Fingerprint checks will now be run through the Washington State Patrol criminal identification system and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The Washington State Patrol requires a resolution to perform this service for Clark County.

GREATER CLARK PARKS DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04-04

BACKGROUND CHECKS

WHEREAS, RCW 35.61.130 requires that the District establish by resolution a requirement for a record check through the Washington state patrol criminal identification system under RCW 43.43.830 through 43.43.834, 10.97.030, and 10.97.050 and through the federal bureau of investigation, including a fingerprint check using a complete Washington state criminal identification fingerprint card for all employees, volunteers, or independent contractors, who may, in the course of their work or volunteer activity with the District, have unsupervised access to children or vulnerable adults, or be responsible for collecting or disbursing cash or processing credit/debit card transactions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COUNTY COUNCILORS of the GREATER CLARK PARKS DISTRICT hereby establish the following policy requiring background checks in compliance with RCW 35.61.130 for all employees, volunteers, or independent contractors, who may, in the course of their work or volunteer activity with the District, have unsupervised access to children or vulnerable adults, or be responsible for collecting or disbursing cash or processing credit/debit card transactions,

- I. When necessary, as determined by the District, prospective employees, volunteers, or independent contractors may be employed on a conditional basis pending completion of the investigation.
- 2. If the prospective employee, volunteer, or independent contractor has had a record check within the previous twelve months, the District may waive the requirement upon receiving a copy of the record.
- 3. The District may in its discretion require that the prospective employee, volunteer, or independent contractor pay the costs associated with the record check.
- 4. The District shall provide a copy of the record report to the employee, volunteer, or independent contractor.
