<p><u>County Administrator</u> County Executive in 1990s. 50s BCC did it all</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Day to Day operations- Auth. for business and service delivery- Implementation and administration of BCC ext. policies- Doing unless BCC gave direction RE: day to day operation- Majority vote would be taken sometimes to clarify- Special projects assigned by BCC- Take direction of issues <p><u>Commissioner</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Direct authority to Co. Administrator to action- Sometimes vote to clarify direction- They had option to do this- This changed depending on the Commissioner- Would use Board Time to give administrator direction- Would delegate contract authority to County Administrator- Open Bids	<p><u>County Manager</u> <u>"All executive powers"</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.
