- Take direction of issues

Commissioner

- Direct authority to Co. Administrator to action
- Sometimes vote to clarify direction
- They had option to do this
- This changed depending on the Commissioner
- Would use Board Time to give administrator direction
- Would delegate contract authority to County Administrator
- Open Bids
