BACKGROUND

In 2017, facilities was approved for a package to replace five county roofs: the Public Service Center (PSC), the Center for Community Health (CCH), the Death Investigation Building, 1408 Franklin Street, and the Courthouse. Due to the improving economy, the roofs have cost us more than we had projected for back in 2016 and early 2017. Facilities has completed the PSC roof, the Death Investigation roof, and are nearly done with the 1408 Franklin Street roof.

We obtained bids for both the CCH and the Courthouse roofs in February and the two projects came to over \$2 million dollars. With the remaining \$954,386 left in the project budget, facilities is unable to afford to complete both roofs at this time. The Courthouse roof has only experienced minor issues and can be salvaged for another year or two with patches and small repairs. The CCH roof has been a constant issue for years, with leaks affecting the tenants that need to be fixed immediately. In the future, the County may be able to apply for another state historical grant to help offset this roofing project. At this time, facilities is asking to repurpose the money from the Courthouse Roofing project and from four other projects that have been completed under budget this biennium. By doing so, we can replace the CCH roof immediately. The repurposed funding and roof budgets are as follows:
