AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PROSECUTION BETWEEN CLARK COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AND THE COWLITZ INDIAN TRIBE

This Extension is made and entered into by and between the Clark County, Washington ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Washington, and the Cowlitz Indian Tribe ("Tribe"), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Parties executed An Agreement for Law Enforcement and Prosecution ("Agreement") on April 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement remains in effect for one (1) year from the date of execution and provides that the Agreement may be extended for one (1) year upon mutual written agreement of the Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed an Amendment to the Agreement ("Amendment") for an additional one (1) year commencing on April 19, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are initiating discussions for a new agreement between the Parties regarding County services; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of continuity of services while negotiating a new agreement, the Parties seek an extension of the Agreement ("Extension");

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

- a. In recognition of the above, the Tribe and County agree that the term of the Amendment is hereby extended for sixty (60) days to expire on June 19, 2019.
- b. County shall receive \$55,000 from the Tribe as compensation for services for this sixty (60) day extension. Amount shall be due within sixty (60) days after mutual execution of this Extension.
- c. All remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement are hereby ratified and confirmed.
