Supplemental Budget Process Overview



Supplemental Budget Appropriations

RCW 36.40 allows for supplemental budget appropriations as needed throughout the budget year. Specific situations where supplemental budget requests are warranted include:

- An unforeseen situation which puts the safety and welfare of the citizens of Clark County at risk.
- An unforeseen situation which hinders the ability of a department or office to fulfill a statutory obligation imposed upon a department manager or elected official.
- A labor contract settlement, legal settlement, or other judgment exceeds those amounts currently available within their current budget.
- Unforeseen revenue source that as associated expenditures such as grants.



The timing of this year's Spring Supplemental is later than it has been in prior years because of the Workday Phase II Financials implementation.

Types of Requests

Each decision package submitted falls into one of these category types:

- **Previously approved by Council** = decision package is a necessary follow up to implement budget changes occurring as a consequence of a staff report previously approved by the Council.
- **Budget Neutral** = decision packages recognizing revenues and associated expenses that were not previously approved by the Council and do not require county funding commitment, such as budget neutral grants, contractual reimbursements or technical adjustments that are not expected to have a material impact on fund balance.
- **Budget Intervention** = these are decision packages that were submitted in response to efforts to find additional efficiencies and additional cost savings as part of the 2019 Budget Deep Dive project.
- **New request** = all other decision packages that impact fund balance, e.g. requests for new funding, reductions in existing funding, revenue forecast updates, grants that require new local match dollars, etc.



2019 Spring Supplemental *countywide requests*

A total of 77 budget requests (decision packages) were received, related to:

- Maintaining service levels, meeting increased workload demands
- Infrastructure upkeep and replacement
- Revenue forecast updates
- Recognizing items with no impact on fund balance: grants, contractual reimbursements, technical adjustments
- Budget Interventions



2019 Spring Supplemental **countywide requests, cont.**

Out of the 77 packages received:

- 12 are Previously approved by Council
- 16 are Budget Neutral
- 2 are Budget Interventions
- **47** are New Requests



County Manager Recommendations



- 76 of the 77 packages submitted are recommended
- 31 of the 77 packages submitted relate to the general fund or have a general fund component



2019 Spring Supplemental *highlights*

2019 County Reorganization Impacts: Decision Package BCC-01-19SP

Savings to the General Fund will be realized in the amount of \$121,816. This includes \$32,208 of onetime savings and \$116,870 of ongoing savings. This reorganization of departments and functions was implemented primarily to increase efficiencies and additionally to realize salary cost savings.

Specific actions accomplished through the reorganization are:

- Indigent Defense moved to Community Services
- Medical Examiner moved to Public Health
- Transportation Planning moved to Public Works
- Developmental Engineering moved Community Development
- Purchasing moved to the Auditor's Office
- General Services Department eliminated
- Internal Services Department created which includes IT, Facilities (Maintenance, Print Shop, Mailroom, Parking, Leases and Contracts), HR, and Budget and Financial Support Office
- Community Outreach, PDR and Communications moved to the County Managers Office



2019 Spring Supplemental *highlights, cont.*

Budget Interventions for the General Fund: As part of the 2019 Budget Deep Dive Project and other budget interventions, a total of \$834,665 in savings will be realized by the General Fund in 2019.

\$362,200 realized in the Deep Dive will be ongoing savings.

- Decision Package BGT-11-19SP: This package recognizes the savings realized to date through the 2019 Budget Deep Dive Project. Impact is a total of \$362,200 ongoing savings to the General Fund. These reductions have been realized by the Human Resources Department, the Treasurer's Office, and Community Planning.
- Decision Package FAC-10-19SP: This package requests a onetime adjustment to realize cost savings relating to the General Fund's support of the Event Center Fund (1003) in the amount of \$472,465.
