REQUESTED ACTION: Approve the Notice to Contractors for the Highway 99 Pavement Improvements, Project #: 372022, to advertise the project for bids.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

The Highway 99 Pavement Improvements project is primarily a pavement preservation project to extend the life of this principal arterial roadway. The project will overlay about 3 miles of Highway 99 from Northeast 78th Street to Northeast 134th Street with asphalt pavement. The project will also update ADA sidewalk curb ramps, update roadway signing, and includes traffic signal work. Public Works received a federal grant for \$3,551,000 to pay for a majority of the project construction.

For the safety of workers and the public, Clark County will temporarily close Northeast 119th Street, just east of Northeast Highway 99, for two weeks during construction in fall of 2019. The road is not wide enough to accommodate traffic in both directions during construction of the ADA curb ramps.

Public Works will advertise for bids after construction funding approval from Washington State Department of Transportation. The advertisement is contained in the attached Notice to Contractors.



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on June 4, 2019** for: **CRP No. 372022, Highway 99 Pavement Improvements.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Improvement of Highway 99 by planing pavement, pavement repair, over-excavation, pre-leveling, hot mix asphalt overlay, concrete sidewalk and curb ramps, traffic signal loops, and traffic signal pedestrian push buttons.

Primary bid items: HMA CL. 3/8 IN. PG 58H-22 (Fiber Reinforced), Planing Bituminous Pavement, Cement Concrete Sidewalk and Curb Ramps, Cement Concrete Traffic Curb, Beam Guardrail, Traffic Signal Systems, Paint Line (pavement striping), Roadway Signing, and Temporary Traffic Control.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

- The Highway 99 Pavement Improvements project is primarily a pavement preservation project to extend the life of this principal arterial roadway.
- The project will overlay about 3 miles of Highway 99 from Northeast 78th Street to Northeast 134th Street with asphalt pavement. The project will also update ADA sidewalk curb ramps, update roadway signing, and includes traffic signal work.
- Public Works received a federal grant for \$3,551,000 to pay for a majority of the project construction.
- During construction there will be single lane closures on Highway 99 where the contractor is working. Due to heavy traffic on Highway 99 the paving work is scheduled to be done at night. Also, Northeast 119th Street will be closed just east of Highway 99 for two weeks in order to construct improvements at the intersection.
