### BACKGROUND

CCPH's NFP program has the opportunity to leverage current NFP funding to apply for a matching grant from the NFP NSO. NFP nurses provide education and support to first time low-income pregnant teens and women, helping new moms and dads become the best parents they can be. The visits last until the child turns two years of age. The nurse helps the client identify her life goals related to education, employment, and positive relationships. Clients are referred to services such as mental health counseling, substance use treatment, and domestic violence support. The need for NFP services in Clark County is great with more requests for services than the program has capacity to meet. The PHN position will allow us to serve 20 more families. The Program Coordinator II's role will include support of the nurse home visitors through weekly reflective supervision meetings, program planning, electronic medical record development, grant writing and reporting. The evidence based NFP program specifies supervisor span of control, so the addition of the Program Coordinator II will ensure we are in fidelity to the program.
