

RESOLUTION No. 2020-03-10

A resolution amending County Human Resources Policy 11.0 Benefits and
Clark County Human Resources Policy 19.0 Other Policies

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020 the Governor of the state of Washington proclaimed that a State of Emergency exists in all counties in the state of Washington as a result of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020, the Clark County Public Health Department confirmed the first case of COVID-19 within Clark County.

WHEREAS, the Director/Health Officer of Clark County Public Health Department has reported to the Clark County Council that beginning March 6, 2020, COVID-19, a potentially life threatening infectious disease was identified in Clark County.

WHEREAS, this COVID-19 can result in serious illness or death and have serious impacts to the health and well-being of the public and can overwhelm the health and medical system in Clark County;

WHEREAS, under the above referenced conditions there is substantial likelihood of risk to the citizens of Clark County and the seven cities therein unless further efforts are taken to reduce the threat; and

WHEREAS, the conditions stated above constitute an emergency for the County, necessitating activation of the Clark County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and the utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to Clark County Code Chapter 2.48A, RCW 38.52.070(2), and 38.52.110(1);

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 38.52 RCW, County Code Chapter 2.48A, and RCW 42.30.070, the County Council of Clark County, Washington does resolve as follows:

Section 1. Clark County Council approves the Addendum to County Human Resources Policy 11.0 Benefits and County Human Resources 19.0 Other Policies, or as identified in Collective Bargaining Agreements with Unions and Guilds dated March 16, 2020. The policy changes as outlined in the Staff Report for the Addendum and the aforementioned Addendum will expire at 11:59 p.m. on August 31, 2020 unless otherwise extended by the Council.


