REQUESTED ACTION: Approve Notice to Contractors for 2020 Joint Agency Road Preservation Project No. 0000069 to advertise for bids.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

The 2020 Road Preservation Surface Seals project will improve and preserve various existing roadways in Clark County by placing slurry seal, chip seal, micro-surfacing, fog seal, striping, pavement marking and other associated work.

RCW 39.34 allows local agencies to partner together when bidding projects to benefit from economy of scale by combining volumes of work. Over the years the City of Vancouver, Clark County, and other local agencies have partnered in bidding their road preservation projects with successful results. The two lead agencies have alternated who bids the project. This year, it is Clark County's responsibility to advertise for bids.

Construction for this process is scheduled for July 2020 and is included in the 2020 budget for road preservation and maintenance.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project supports the council's policy of providing of providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. This project is included in the 2020 budget for road preservation and maintenance.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

A few months prior to start of construction all impacted households receive a notification with information about the project. Additionally, households will receive notice from the contractor in the form of door hangers. These are posted seven days and twenty-four to forty-eight hours in advance of the work on their street. Some roadways may have portable changeable message signs notifying the public of traffic delays. The signs will be placed on these roads for three days prior to work beginning and for the duration of construction.



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on March 24, 2020** for: **Project No. 0000069, 2020 Joint Agency Road Preservation Project.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: This Contract provides for the improvement and preservation of various roadways in Clark County by placing slurry seal, chip seal, micro-surfacing, striping and pavement marking, and other associated work.

Primary bid items: Latex Modified Slurry Seal, Type __ ; 3/8-Inch Asphalt Rubber Chip Seal; Micro-Surfacing, Type __ ; Asphalt for Fog Seal; Traffic Control (various bid items); and Pavement Marking (various bid items).

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.



Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

Clark County in accordance with Title VI of the Civil rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

The County reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, reject any or all bids, or cancel the bid if the best interests of Clark County are not served.
