REQUESTED ACTION: Approve Notice to Contractors for 2020 ADA Compliance -
Group 1 Project No. 391322 to advertise for bids.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

The 2020 ADA Compliance Group 1 project will construct or upgrade sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act regulations. The work will include concrete curb ramps, sidewalks, curbs, detectable warning surface, and other associated work.

This work includes 24 ramps at 14 locations throughout Clark County:

- Six locations on Northeast 107th Avenue;
- Two locations on Northeast 102nd Avenue;
- Two locations on Northeast 40th Avenue;
- Two locations on Northeast 58th Avenue;
- One location on Northwest Anderson Avenue; and
- One location on Northeast Hazel Dell Avenue.

Detectable warning surfaces will also be installed at two additional locations on Northeast 107th Avenue. The detectable warning surfaces provide guidance for visually impaired pedestrians.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project supports the council's policy of providing a safe and efficient transportation system for all county residents.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program, 2020 Annual Construction Program (No. 20) and the 2020 budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Public outreach to date has included communication with affected property owners regarding the purpose of the project, information gathering and potential impacts. Future outreach will follow up with property owners in the project area prior to construction.

Development of the 2020-2025 TIP included a Clark County Council work session, presentations to the Clark County Planning Commission, the Development and Engineering Advisory Board, Public Open Houses, Clark County Fair and neighborhood associations. A State Environmental Policy Act review provided an additional opportunity for public comment.



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on March 24, 2020** for: **CRP No. 391322, 2020 ADA Compliance - Group 1.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: The 2020 ADA Compliance Group 1 project will construct or upgrade sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regulations. Improve sidewalks and ADA ramps, including curb and pavement restoration, and detectable warning surface retrofits, at various locations in Clark County.

Primary bid items: Construction Surveying; Crushed Surfacing Base Course; HMA CL. ½ In. PG58H-22; Cement Conc. Traffic Curb and Gutter; Cement Conc. Pedestrian Curb; Cement Conc. Sidewalk; Cement Conc. Curb Ramp, Detectable Warning Surface and Traffic Control.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.



Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory contract bond, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to Clark County.

Clark County in accordance with Title VI of the Civil rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

The County reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, reject any or all bids, or cancel the bid if the best interests of Clark County are not served.




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
