REQUESTED ACTION: Approve Notice to Contractors for 2020 Catch Basin Retrofit Project No. 405634 to advertise for bids.

Consent Hearing County Manager

BACKGROUND

This project will provide water quality treatment for stormwater from 15 existing catch basins (stormwater drains) by intercepting the water using one new stormwater treatment vault. These 15 existing catch basins currently send untreated water into Chicken Creek and Vancouver Lake. The project will improve overall water quality in Chicken Creek and Vancouver Lake.

The project design is complete and ready for contractor bidding and construction.

COUNCIL POLICY IMPLICATIONS

This project supports the capital improvement policies and goals of the county's Stormwater Management Plan and addresses National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit requirements for retrofitting the stormwater system.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY IMPLICATIONS

None. The project is included in the 2019-2024 Stormwater Capital Plan and funding is included in the approved 2020 Clean Water Division budget.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

This project is part of the Stormwater Capital Program and the county's Stormwater Management Plan. The Clean Water Commission reviews the Stormwater Management Plan. The Clark County Council adopts the plan, which is posted on the Public Works county website.

All work will be completed within Clark County's right-of-way. Prior to construction, nearby residents and property owners will be notified of the project.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by Clark County, Washington until **1:50 P.M. on April 7, 2020** for: **Project No. 405634, 2020 Catch Basin Retrofit Project.**

Sealed bids shall be delivered to the office of Clark County Purchasing, Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650, Vancouver, Washington 98660 (or P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, WA 98666-5000). Bids delivered to locations other than as indicated above or received after the time indicated above will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, on the same day in the Hearing Room of the Clark County Council, 6th Floor of the Public Service Center.

Description of work: Storm water quality retrofit on NW 78th Street. Work to be performed includes removal and construction of pavement, median, curb and gutter, manholes, stormlines and storm filter units.

Primary bid items: Traffic Control, Storm pipe and Storm Structure Installation, Concrete, Asphalt.

Bid documents can be viewed, downloaded, or purchased on the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) website www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Bidders are encouraged to "Register as a Bidder" in order to receive automatic email notification of future addenda and to be placed on the Bidders List. Electronic and paper copies of bid documents are not available from Clark County.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to obtain Addenda, if any. Such information may be obtained from the Builders Exchange of Washington (BXWA) web site, www.bxwa.com (Posted Projects, Public Works, Clark County and Projects Bidding). Clark County accepts no responsibility or liability and will provide no accommodation to bidders who fail to check for addenda and submit inadequate or incomplete bids.

Questions and requests for clarification must be submitted using the electronic "CRP Inquiry Submittal Form" located on the County website, <https://www.clark.wa.gov/general-services/public-works-roads-parks-clean-water-projects>. Responses will be posted on the project's "Bid Inquiry Log".

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid documents. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the Bidder's company name, project title, project number, bid opening date, and "SEALED BID" clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond in an amount of at least five percent (5%) of the total bid.


